In the airline industry, timing is everything. And when your business runs on precision and scale, inefficient procurement workflows can slow everything down. Jazeera Airways, a leading airline carrier based in Kuwait, recognized this risk and decided to launch a digital transformation plan to modernize its procurement and supplier onboarding process.

With a growing network of destinations and complex internal controls, the Jazeera team needed a procurement system that could move as quickly and compliantly. Leading that transformation was Vinod D'Souza, Finance Coordinator. Vinod selected Raindrop to streamline the purchasing process, as the solution could scale with the airline's growth while meeting rigorous audit and compliance requirements.



CLEARING OPERATIONAL TURBULENCE OVERCOMING THE BOTTLENECKS OF MANUAL PROCUREMENT

Before Raindrop, Jazeera's procurement process relied heavily on paper and manual approvals. Each PO required multiple physical signatures, from department initiators to Finance heads. This results in a process that could take anywhere from a day to a full week.

The decentralized, paper-based workflow posed several key challenges:

- Time delays and bottlenecks caused by approver availability and manual routing
- Lack of audit readiness and inconsistent record-keeping across departments
- Limited visibility into procurement activity, especially across
- Supplier onboarding inefficiencies, which stalled PO issuance

PREPARING PROCUREMENT FOR TAKEOFF

To address these issues, Jazeera Airways selected Raindrop as a centralized, automated platform for issuing POs and procurement governance. Working closely with Raindrop's implementation team, Vinod and his colleague in Finance, Srinivas Krishnan, built a detailed approval matrix tailored to Jazeera's internal controls and delegation of authority.

"It was a big challenge to bring everyone from manual to the system," shared Vinod. "At first, we trained everyone together, but later moved to department specific sessions, and that really helped."

Raindrop's Customer Support team played a critical role in Jazeera's success. They were quick to respond, provided detailed guides, and ensured coordination was smooth and efficient. The team also taught Vinod to manage workflow changes so Jazeera could keep improving the process without any delays. Vinod described the support as "outstanding" and "very commendable."

- Document and contract upload to support finance audit trails
- Hands-on onboarding and training, ensure full adoption

TRANSFORMING PROCUREMENT EFFICIENCY AT SCALE

Since implementation, Jazeera has seen dramatic improvements in procurement speed, governance, and control. Some of the most significant improvements include:

- 95% reduction in PO processing time, down from days to minutes
- 90%+ of managed spend processed through Raindrop
- Improved compliance with full audit logs and documentation aligned to internal policies
- Greater agility, enabling urgent orders (even after hours) through draft workflows and email confirmations
- Flexible workflow ownership with in-house capability to manage and tweak approval chains without waiting on external help
